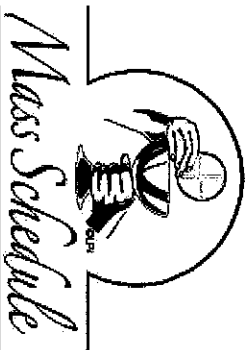

**-St. Anne's church is open weekdays from 9am.-noon & 1-4pm.**

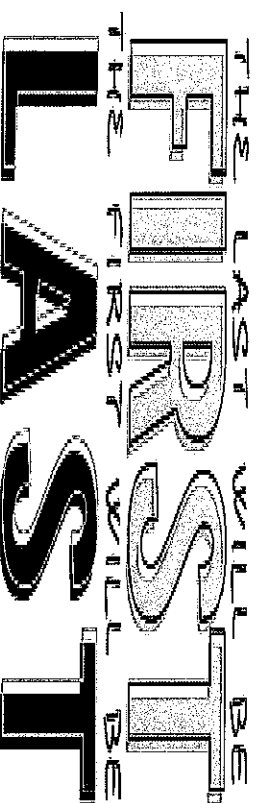
**Baptism & Marriage Certificates:**
