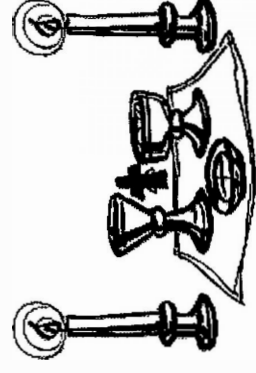

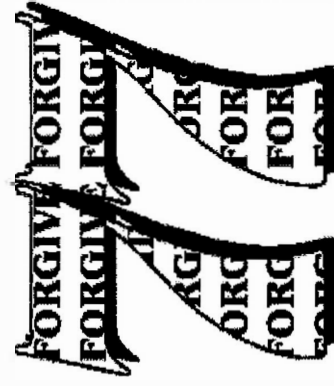
Marriage- Please arrange an appointment at least six months prior to your wedding.
